A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to making an appropriation of money from the economic
3 stabilization fund for expenditure during the current state fiscal

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. (a) The amount of \$3,198,661,120 is appropriated
7 from the economic stabilization fund to the comptroller of public
8 accounts for the purpose of depositing that amount to the credit of
9 the general revenue fund as money available for use during the state
10 fiscal year ending August 31, 2011, to make expenditures previously
11 authorized by appropriations from general revenue for the state
12 fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2011.

13 (b) This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of
14 three-fifths of the members present in each house of the
15 legislature, as provided by Section 49-g(k), Article III, Texas
16 Constitution, and is subject to certification by the comptroller of
17 public accounts as provided by that subsection.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately.

House Bill 275

Section-by-Section Analysis

HOUSE VERSION

SECTION 1. (a) Appropriates the amount of ***\$3,117,661,120*** from the economic stabilization fund to the comptroller of public accounts for the purpose of depositing that amount to the credit of the general revenue fund as money available for use during the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2011, to make expenditures previously authorized by appropriations from general revenue for the state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2011.

(b) Makes this act effective only if it receives a vote of three-fifths of the members present in each house of the legislature, as provided by Section 49-g(k), Article III, Texas Constitution, and subject to certification by the comptroller of public accounts as provided by that subsection.

(c) Makes this act effective only if H.B. No. 4, 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, or another Act of the 82nd Legislature substantially similar in effect to that legislation, is enacted and becomes law.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect ***July 1, 2011***.

SENATE VERSION (CS)

SECTION 1. (a) Same as House version except sets the appropriated amount at ***\$3,973,557,000***.

(b) Substantially the same as House version.

No equivalent provision.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect ***immediately***.

CONFERENCE

SECTION 1. (a) Same as House version except sets the appropriated amount at ***\$3,198,661,120***.

(b) Same as House version.

Fiscal Analysis

The bill relates to making appropriations from the Economic Stabilization Fund - 0599 in fiscal year 2011.

The appropriation would take effect only if the bill receives a vote of three-fifths of the members in

each house of the Legislature, as provided by Article III, Section 49-g(k) of the Texas Constitution.

Methodology

The bill appropriates \$3,198,661,120 from the Economic Stabilization Fund for the purpose of making expenditures previously authorized by appropriations from the General Revenue Fund for the 2010-11 biennium.
