BACKGROUND

School districts are required to select a bank located in Texas as a depository every two years through a competitive bidding process. The school district selects the highest and best bid on basis of interest rates offered, charges for keeping district accounts and records, and other matters that the school

board determines would be in the best interest of the district.

DIGEST: SB 656 would allow school districts to extend a depository contract with a

bank for one additional two-year period.

SB 656 would take immediate effect if finally approved by a two-thirds

record vote of the membership in each house.
