BACKGROUND: Government Code, sec. 325.007 requires a state agency subject to a Sunset

review, before September 1 of the odd-numbered year before the year in which the agency would be abolished, to provide the Sunset Commission with a report containing information relating to the agency's continuation.

DIGEST: HB 326 would require a state agency subject to a Sunset review, before

September 1 of the odd-numbered year before the year in which the agency would be abolished, to provide the governor, the lieutenant governor, and members of the Legislature a list of reports the agency was

required to prepare for the Sunset Advisory Commission and an evaluation

regarding the continued need for those reports.

The bill would take effect immediately if it received two-thirds vote from

both houses; otherwise, it would take effect on September 1, 2011.
