DIGEST:	HB 3388 would require a state agency with a fleet of more that vehicles to establish and maintain a reporting system to assist management of its vehicle fleet.	
	Such a state agency would be excepted from submitting a repo Office of Vehicle Fleet Management on a quarterly basis, and	

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would have to submit by October 15 of each year to the office the information the office requested regarding the agency's vehicle fleet for the previous fiscal year. The agency could provide the information in the format used by the agency's reporting system.

Such agencies also would be exempt from paying to the office any fee for maintaining the office's vehicle reporting system.

Each state agency the bill applied to would have to establish a vehicle reporting system by October 1, 2021, and submit the first report to the office by October 15, 2021, or a later date determined by the office.

The bill would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds record vote of the membership of each house. Otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2021.
