BACKGROUND: Some have suggested that providing the Texas Department of Motor

Vehicles (TxDMV) the option to offer embossed license plates could meet

a specialty license plate customer preference.

DIGEST: HB 3187 would require that a contract between the TxDMV and certain

private vendors would have to allow for the establishment of a range of premium embossed specialty license plates to be sourced, marketed, and

sold by the vendor.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2023.
