DIGEST

The Texas DeMolay Association is an organization for young men between the ages of 13 years and 20 years of age. For the past 20 years Texas DeMolay has had the privilege of holding its mock legislative sessions in the State Capitol. These mock legislative sessions provide young people with the opportunity to gain first-hand knowledge of how our government works at the historical setting of the State Capitol.

PURPOSE

As proposed, S.C.R. 4 submits the following resolution:
