DIGEST

The 72nd Legislature created the 42nd Judicial District, in which a district attorney is elected to prosecute criminal cases in Coleman County. The legislature did not subsequently repeal the authority of the district attorney of the 35th Judicial District to prosecute criminal cases in Coleman County. H.B. 2937 repeals law in the Government Code regarding duties of the district attorney of the 35th Judicial District.

PURPOSE

As proposed, H.B. 2937 repeals law in the Government Code regarding duties of the district attorney of the 35th Judicial District.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Repealer: Section 43.121(b), Government Code (regarding duties of the district attorney for the 35th Judicial District).

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. Emergency clause.
