### **DIGEST**

Currently, Texas law does not provide for student health centers on public school campuses. S.B. 1454 would establish student health centers on public school campuses.

### **PURPOSE**

As proposed, S.B. 1454 provides for student health centers on public school campuses.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Chapter 38, Education Code, by adding Section 38.011, as follows:

Sec. 38.011. SCHOOL-BASED STUDENT HEALTH CENTERS. Sets forth requirements for school-based student health centers.

SECTION 2. Requires the Texas Education Agency, with assistance from the Health and Human Services Commission to take certain action.

SECTION 3. Emergency clause.  
Effective date: upon passage.
