DIGEST AND PURPOSE

During the 75th legislative session, a limit was set allowing municipalities with a certain minimum population to collect certain fees generated from the conviction of certain offenses for the funding of certain child safety programs. H.B. 374 removes the population requirement for a municipality to collect these fees.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Amends Article 102.014(c), Code of Criminal Procedure, to delete existing text regarding municipalities with a certain population size.

SECTION 2. Makes application of this Act prospective.

SECTION 3. Effective date: September 1, 2001.
