## **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently the Education Code provides funding for the transportation of a "regular eligible student" to and from school. The current definition of "regular eligible student" is unclear as to whether it includes those students who attend a magnet school. This bill codifies a rule allowing the transportation allotment to be spent on transporting students to and from magnet schools and clarifies that the funding does include transportation of students to magnet schools.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 42.155 (b)(1), Education Code, by redefining "regular eligible student" to include a student from a magnet school campus.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2001.
