### **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently, judges serving the 12th, 258th, and 278th judicial districts are authorized to select their bailiffs. As proposed, S.B. 1889 allows the judge of the 411th judicial district to select a bailiff to serve the court.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 53.002(f), Government Code, to add the 411th district court to the list of district courts which are authorized to appoint a bailiff.

SECTION 2. Amends Section 53.009(k), Government Code, to make a conforming change relating to the judge of the 411th district court appointing a bailiff.

SECTION 3. Effective date: September 1, 2003.
