DIGEST AND PURPOSE

S.B. 1955 provides the power of eminent domain and the power to issue bonds relating to the Red River Redevelopment Authority.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION 5. Repealer: (a) Section 396.065(b), Local Government Code.

(b) Sections 1-4 and 6, Chapter 1312, Acts of the 76th Legislature,
Regular Session, 1999.

SECTION 6. Provides that the legislature validates and confirms all legitimate governmental acts and proceedings of the authority.

SECTION 7. Sets forth legislative findings.

SECTION 8. Provides that to the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails.

SECTION 9. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2003.
