**DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently, no conservation and reclamation district exists for Clear Fork Creek. As proposed, S.B. 24 creates the Ranch at Clear Fork Creek Municipal Utility District No. 1 (MUD). The MUD will be totally located within Caldwell County and is subject to a confirmation election.
