To the Secretary of State:

By the authority vested in me by
the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, I
hereby file with you Senate Bill No. 265, with my
disapproval of same.

This bill is vetoed because I find
that the Legislature, inadvertently, I am sure, passed
two bills identically the same; this bill and House
Bill No. 132 being exactly in the same language and
containing the same provisions. I have already approved
House Bill No. 132, and for that reason Senate Bill No.
265 is hereby vetoed and disapproved.
