

Dear Mr. Secretary:

I am filing with you, together with my veto
and disapproval, Senate Bill No. 20.

This bill appropriates Fifteen Thousand Dollars to employ additional inspectors for the Live Stock Sanitary Commission. This bill was inadvertently omitted some days ago when I vetoed bills appropriating something more than Thirty-nine Million Dollars. It should have been included in that list, and for the same reason stated in connection therewith, which was that the Legislature had appropriated money far in excess of the revenues of the State.
