

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 14 of the Constitution of Texas, I herewith veto House Bill 1550 for the following reasons:

This year is the current year for brand re-registration in Texas. House Bill 1550 was passed to make needed changes in the registration dates for future years. The problem is that it has provisions for the timing of brand re-registration for 1981. It has been shown by the livestock industry and county clerks that the provisions for 1981 will cause confusion, that even though inadvertent, should be avoided. Other provisions of House Bill 1550 may be helpful in ten years when we have another re-registration. Between now and that time legislation can be passed that can include these provisions.

To avoid the confusion and allow the use of the current system for re-registration I therefore veto House Bill 1550.
