

Library Resources Win NCSL Awards

Texas Legislators Past & Present recipient of the "Model Historical Database" award, contains biographical information, terms of service, and committee service of members of the Legislature back to the 15th Legislature (1876). The database can be searched by name, session, gender, chamber, party, leadership roles, committee membership, and Home city and county. The Texas Legislative Reference Library has been **recognized** with two Notable Documents Awards by the National Conference of State Legislatures, Legislative Research Librarians Staff section. 38 documents from 11 states were submitted for the award, with 13 receiving the honor. The awards will be presented at the 37th NCSL Legislative Summit in San Antonio, Texas, on Thursday, August 11.
